



Neighborhood Advisory for: Modjeska Canyon Rd. Pipeline Relocation

Project: September 2012 – In June 2012, the County of Orange began construction of its storm drain system in Modjeska Canyon Road, near Olive Grove Lane. During the design phase for the County's project, IRWD was informed that the storm drain alignment conflicted with IRWD's alignment of an existing 8-inch drinking water pipeline also located in Modjeska Canyon Road. IRWD determined its existing waterline would require relocation.

IRWD will construct a replacement 8-inch drinking waterline in Modjeska Canyon Road and will abandon the existing pipeline due to its alignment conflict with the County's storm drain. Roads will remain open during construction, although lane closures are expected. Water to residences and businesses will not be affected by this construction. At the conclusion of this construction, a water shutdown will be required to connect customers to the new waterline. A future community notification will be provided three days prior to the shutdown and will be delivered to only the affected customers.

Schedule and Work Hours – The contractor will begin construction in September 2012, and total project completion is expected late November 2012. Primary work hours for this project are 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. IRWD will keep the community informed via project information and updates available on IRWD's website at www.irwd.com.
