## Moving Checklist

Send your address change to:

- Post office
- Charge cards, Credit Cards
- Subscriptions (requires several week's notice)
- Friends & Relatives

### Bank

- Transfer money, investments etc.
- Order new cheques in advance of your move
- Arrange cheque cashing if relocating to new city

**Insurance:** Notify new location for coverages for:

- Life
- Health
- Fire
- Auto

### Automobile

- Transfer vehicle registration
- Apply for new Driver's License; if applicable
- Join Motor Club in new city

### Utility Companies

- Gas
- Hydro
- Water
- Telephone
- Cable TV

- Arrange to receive any refunds for previous deposits in old city**

### Arrange for immediate service in new city

- Routes, Newspaper, Milkman etc.
- School Services
- Medical, Dental, Optometrist, Specialists
- Request referrals in new city
- Churches, Clubs, Civic Organizations
- Transfer memberships, ask for letters of referral and introduction
- Pets: Licenses, vaccinations, tags, city bylaws

**Don't forget to:**

- Have appliances serviced for moving
- Empty freezer (plan to use your food in advance)
- Defrost freezer (refrigerator)
- Clean rugs, clothing before your move

**Movers**

- Check insurance coverage before moving day
- Packing and unpacking duties
- Arrival time in new city
- Receive shipping documents, methods and time of payment

**On Moving Day:**

- Carry money, jewellery, documents on your person – do not pack
- Plan for pet transportation and carry crate(s) with you
- Carry Traveller's cheques or credit cards for quick cash
- Double check closets, drawers and shelves to ensure you have packed everything and nothing is left behind
- Leave all old keys with solicitor, rental agent or new owner
- Use a close friend or relative as a message centre; inform them of your travel route and schedule, including overnight stops that you may make
