<p>SMOKING, DRINKING, DRUG USE <i>This is for your personal use. We will not adjudicate from this agreement, however if you are found in violation all residents may be subject to the judicial process. Cazenovia College is a smoke free campus and smoking is not permitted on the grounds.</i></p>
<p>NOISE & STUDY TIMES <i>What hours do you like to sleep, wake up, nap? Can you sleep with background noise and/or light? What hours do you like to study and hang out? Do you prefer the room to be primarily for studying, socializing, or somewhere in between?</i></p>
<p>GUESTS <i>When are they allowed? Not Allowed? Who is allowed? Do you prefer or require advance notice for guests? How much notice? Is there a difference for the previously mentioned items in regards to daytime and overnight guests?</i></p>
<p>LIVING ENVIRONMENT <i>Do you prefer your room neat or organized chaos? Do you have a temperature preference, if applicable? How will this be regulated?</i></p>
<p>ADDITIONAL ITEMS & CONCERNS <i>Are there any other living expectations important to you?</i></p>

I realize that my roommate and I have equal rights to use the space and facilities in this room with the exception of the areas we have designated in this agreement. This contract is intended to promote communication and respect between roommates by clarifying the expectations and responsibilities of the roommates to each other. The roommates may revisit this agreement at any time.
