MUA Rule 11 – RESIGNATION FROM MEMBERSHIP

- a) A member of the Union may resign from membership by written notice addressed and delivered to the Branch Secretary.
- b) Such notice of resignation from Membership of the Union takes effect:
 - (i) Where the Member ceases to be eligible to become a Member of the Union
 - (1) On the day on which the notice is received by the Union; or
 - (2) On the day specified in the notice, which is a day not earlier than the day when the member ceases to be eligible to become a member;

Whichever is later; or

- (ii) in any other case:

- (1) At the end of two weeks after the notice is received by the Union; or
- (2) On the day specified in the notice;

Whichever is later.

- c) A Notice delivered to the Branch Secretary shall be taken to have been received by the Union when it was delivered.
- d) A notice of resignation that has been received by the Union is not invalid because it was not addressed and delivered in accordance with Sub Rule (a).
- e) A resignation from Membership is valid even if it is not effected in accordance with the Rule if the member is informed in writing by you or on behalf of the Union that the resignation has been accepted.
- f) Upon receipt of a notice of resignation the Branch Secretary shall forward a copy of it to the National Secretary
- g) Any dues payable but not paid by a former member of the Union, in relation to a period before the member's resignation from the Union took effect, may be sued for and recovered in the name of the Union, in a court of competent jurisdiction as a debt due to the Union
