
Script Format for Students

This format works well for students creating simple, clear scripts for presentations, short videos, or skits.

[Title]

Name of the project or presentation.

[Purpose/Overview]

A brief description of the objective or topic.

[Scene or Section Heading]

e.g., *Introduction, Body, Conclusion*

[Action]

A description of what each person is doing in the scene. Keep it short and clear.

[Character Name/Student Name]

Who is speaking or acting.

[Dialogue]

The lines they're supposed to say, straightforward and easy to read.

Example:

Title: *World War II Presentation*

Purpose/Overview:

To inform classmates about the key events of World War II.

Introduction

SAM

Today, we're talking about World War II, which lasted from 1939 to 1945.

Action: Sam points to a map of Europe.

JESSICA

It involved major powers from around the world and had lasting effects on global politics.

Conclusion

ALL
