Greetings from the 2017 Quilt Arkansas Committee!

Is there a technique that you want to share with your quilting friends? Do you have a pattern that you would like to share with a group? Would you like to gain experience teaching quilting classes? We have a great opportunity for you!

The Quilt Arkansas Committee is currently accepting proposals for classes taught by local teachers, and we, the committee, are excited to see what you have to share with the guild.

Those who teach full-day (6 hour) classes will receive:

- \$300.00 for teaching
- Lodging for the day the class is taught
- Meals for the day the class is taught (breakfast, lunch, and dinner)
- Mileage up to 100 miles

Those who teach half-day (3 hour) classes will receive:

- \$150.00 for teaching
- Meals for the day the class is taught (breakfast, lunch, and dinner)
- Mileage up to 100 miles

Proposals for classes should contain the following information:

- Your name and contact information
- Title of Class, primary technique used, and a description of what will be achieved
- A maximum class size you are comfortable teaching
- Whether the class is half-day or full-day
- If the class will provide a kit, and how much the kit would cost students in the class
- A picture of the project, if available

The deadline to submit class proposals will be January 1st, 2017. Proposals can be emailed to Angie Heifner (agheifner@icloud.com) or Meg Cullum (meg.motley@gmail.com). All proposals will be carefully considered by the committee. If your class is accepted, class "samples" (pictures, supply lists, physical samples) must be made available prior to the event for class advertisement purposes.
