

## Automobile Mileage Log

This is an example of a vehicle log that contains the information required to support a claim for input tax credits of the use of a vehicle. This vehicle log has been provided for your convenience. It does not replace the need to retain all records that pertain to the operation of the vehicle.

This is how to complete the log: (refer to the attached example)

1. Record the name and address of the vehicle owner and the GST registration number.
2. Record the make and year of the vehicle.
3. Begin a new page for each month of the log.
4. For each trip during the month, record:
  - a. The date of the trip and the odometer reading at the beginning of the trip.
  - b. The point of origin (place trip began), a description of the trip, and the nature of the goods/services involved.
  - c. The odometer reading at the end of the trip and how many kilometres were driven.
  - d. Allocate on a reasonable basis the amount of kilo metres driven for business use and the amount for non-business use. Combined trips for personal and business use require an allocation be made since it is not entirely business use.
5. At the end of the month complete the Summary Section as follows:
  - a. Record the vehicle odometer reading at the end of the month in space 'A'.
  - b. Subtract 'B' from 'A' to get the total kilometres driven and record this amount in space 'C'.
  - c. Add total distance traveled for business from column 'Bus. KM' and enter in space 'D'.
  - d. Multiply space 'D' by 100 and divide this total by the total in space 'C' to get the percentage of business use for the vehicle. Record this amount in space 'E'.
