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NARRATION: READING WALL OF FAME

Our staff is great ones to really get into the spirit of Reading. They love to show their support of reading by participating in a Reading Wall of Fame. This time the **theme** of the wall is “I would rather be Reading” with them photographed doing something humorous they would much prefer to Read than do. Examples could be; the Nurse getting a shot, the janitor cleaning up a mess, the band director listening to an off key instrument, and the vice-principal calling a parent.

This is a log of their personal reading for the week. Each grade level advisory whose students have read the most minutes will win a class party.
