

KIDS CHORE CHART

AGES 2-3

TODDLERS

- Help make the beds
- Pick up and put toys in bins
- Collect dirty clothes in the hamper
- Fold simple items like t-shirts and socks

AGES 4-5

PRE-K & KINDERGARTEN

- Make the bed
- Get dressed
- Brush teeth with a parent's help
- Wash face with a parent's help
- Put toys away
- Help set and clear the table
- Sort laundry by colors
- Fill pet's food and water bowls
- Carry in light groceries
- Help a parent dust
- Water plants
- Clear up spills
- Prepare simple snacks

AGES 6-11

ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

All chores for the pre-k and kindergarten years, plus:

- Choose their own clothing
- Personal hygiene
- Take care of belongings
- Be responsible for homework
- Fold and put away laundry
- Clean their bedroom
- Dust by themselves
- Empty trash cans
- Wash dishes
- Sweep floors
- Wake up with alarm clock
- Use the washer and dryer

AGES 12-14

MIDDLE SCHOOL

All chores for the elementary school years, plus:

- Change bedsheets
- Sweep, mop, and vacuum
- Clean the bathroom
- Mow lawn with supervision
- Prepare simple meals with supervision

AGES 15-18

HIGH SCHOOL

All chores for the earlier teen years, plus:

- Yard work like weeding and raking leaves
- Prepare meals themselves
- Wash windows
- Earn money through babysitting or outside jobs
- Purchase some clothing and personal items themselves
- Wash and maintain vehicle when they start to drive
