



Part 1 Requirements:

1. Read a Fiction Book that is at least 45 pages in length or longer (*chapter book*).
2. Then on the provided attached sheet of paper, fill in the following in complete sentences on the student data form neatly written in cursive or manuscript by **Wednesday, February 21st**:
 - a. Characters – Make a list of top 3 characters in the book. Describe the main character.
 - b. Setting – Describe in detail one of the settings where the story takes place the most.
 - c. Problem – Describe in detail one of the problems in the story. Use lots of detail.
 - d. Solution – Describe in detail how the problem was solved.
 - e. Summary – Describe in detail what the story was about. Make sure to include only important details.
 - f. New Words Learned – Write the 2-3 new words learned and either provide the definition or use it in a sentence correctly.


Part 2 Requirements: (*Parent Assistance will be needed on this part.*)

* You will receive the new pizza box when I receive Part 1 completed.

1. You will need to cut 2 large circles (*paper or thin foam board*) of the same size that fit within the pizza box.

* *Using a large mixing bowl can help you in this task.*

2. Both of the circles you will need to divide into sixths. The top circle you will need to label it, and cut out the slices, please see note and image below for ideas/suggestions.



For Circle that is labeled, make sure that you either (1) glue down the edges of the piece or (2) don't cut it all the way giving it about ½ inch of a boarder edge so that it won't come loose when people flip open the pizza slice to see what the answer is under it.

3. You will need to put the information for each subject on the bottom circle (*it can be written neatly in Cursive/Manuscript or Typed*), then glue it to the pizza box.

4. You will need to decorate the top circle with the labels to look like a pizza (*with all those yummy toppings*). You can draw them on, download small images of the various toppings and color them then glue them, can use colored thin foam board to decorate it or fabric like felt. This can be a regular pizza or a dessert pizza, your choice. For some of the toppings, buttons can work nicely. Use your imagination.
5. Carefully, match the top labeled sections with the bottom sections.
6. On the inside top cover of the Pizza Box, your child will need to on another sheet of paper (*hand written or typed*) put:
 - a. Their Name in the upper Left Hand Side.
 - b. The Title of the Book/Author
 - c. Draw a scene from the story they read.

7. Possible Extra Credit Points (*10 points total*) --

* For 5 extra credit points * -- You can decorate the top outside cover of the box with pictures from the story and on the outside edges of the Pizza box, or you can put just plain paper on the outside edges instead of drawing on them because of the small spacing.

* For 5 extra credit points * -- You can come up with a name of your "Pizza Shop" that has something to do with the book you read. Be creative in your name. Then Decorate the top outside cover of the pizza box with it, and you can also add some information about your stores "made up" contact information like Phone Number, Address, e-mail address for those "on-line" orders.

Note: You can do both of the extra credits, just designate half of the top outside cover for the "Pizza Shop Name", and the other half for the picture from the story.
