Children crossing the state border

Crossing of state border by children is regulated by the Act on Travel Documents of Croatian Nationals, State Border Protection Act, Act on Movement and Stay of Aliens, and bilateral agreements.

Children can cross the state border on the basis of their own passport, joint passport, and nationals of some countries (Slovenia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Italy and Hungary) on the basis of an identity card.

If they are not accompanied by their parents or a legal guardian, a letter of authorisation signed by both parents is needed, entitled to the person the child is travelling with.

In cases of group student trips, in addition to their parent's letter of authorisation, entitled to their guide, children need to possess appropriate travel documents.

Children who are Croatian nationals can cross the Croatian-Slovenian border exclusively if they possess an identity card or passport, and if they are not accompanied by their parents or a legal guardian, they also need to possess their parents' letter of authorisation.
