- **Activate your Smith email account.**
From this point on the only email account we will use to communicate with you is your Smith account. Instructions for activating your account were already sent to the email address you provided on your application for admission. We will send several electronic messages over the summer so please check your Smith email regularly! If you are having trouble accessing your Smith email, please call the User Support Center at 413-585-4487.
- **Purchase and read the 2019 Smith Reads selection.**

- **Sign in to the Smith Social Network.**

- **Register for your Orientation Group Program.**
Each member of the Class of 2023 will participate in an Orientation Group during the overall Orientation program. Groups are interest-specific and you can choose which group you would like to be in. - **Download the CORQ app.**

- **Take required placement exams.**
Information can be found on the [Registrar's website](#) about departments that offer placement exams. Many departments have online exams that must be completed before you arrive on campus.
- **Complete the "SMART" module.**
All first-year and transfer students are required to complete the Smythbusters online tutorial, a 45-minute online program created by your fellow Smithies. You will watch a series of videos and take a series of quizzes. A link to the tutorial will be sent to you via your Smith email from wellness@smith.edu beginning August 1.
