

Sparta High School Musical Commitment Contract

Being a part of a theatre production at Sparta High School requires a commitment to and respect for all aspects of the production process. From the auditions to rehearsals to build days to performances, the student-actor is expected to maintain a high level of integrity and loyalty to the cast and directors involved in the production. This contract serves to spell out the expectations of students who are cast in a SHS production.

Attendance to rehearsals is mandatory. Students who wish to be involved in the production must attend rehearsals as indicated in the provided rehearsal schedule. All known conflicts to the provided rehearsal schedule must be made known to the directors immediately. Missing rehearsals or performances for any reason (beyond pre-approved absences) will not be tolerated and the individual may be recast or removed from involvement in the production. Recasting or removal from the show may also occur based on the behavior of the actor during rehearsals.

In addition to the reasons listed prior, a student-actor may be recast or removed from the production for behavior deemed unacceptable including, but not limited to:

- Any disciplinary referral
- Repeated tardiness to rehearsal or class
- Any unexcused absence from school or rehearsal
- Illegal activity or behavior
- Any behavior during rehearsals, productions, school functions, etc.
- Disrespect of any kind towards directors, teachers, students, administrators, parents or school personnel
- Lack of or improper communication with the director
- Inability to follow direction from the director, student leader, or any personnel involved in the production
- Inability or failure as determined by the director of the student to fulfill a task in an appropriate manner or time

In addition to the student-actors commitment, the success of a SHS theatre production is high dependent on parents involvement. There are many opportunities for the parents to aid in the production process. Non-cast parents or volunteers are also welcome and encouraged to participate in the productions.

The construction and dressing of the set, the gathering of props, the collection, construction, and organization of costumes, and many other technical theatre aspects require the collaboration of many people.

We take theatre very seriously at Sparta high School and seek the create enjoyable rewarding, and quality opportunities for its students. We believe that these opportunities are most beneficial for all students involved when we all come committed to the production and its success. Please feel free to communicate with Ms. DeLuccia if you have any questions or concerns. Students will not be allowed to participate in rehearsals and could be removed from the cast if this contract is not signed and returned.
