

Weekly Plan for Online Learning – Kingwood Park High School

The following framework outlines our weekly plan for sharing learning opportunities and supporting student learning.

Weekly Learning Plan

Each Monday, students can expect teachers to post the class learning plan for the week **AT 9:00 am** in Schoology.

- It will include an outline of learning opportunities, which are to be completed by the following Monday at 9:00 am, as well as information about how teachers can be contacted for support and questions.
- Students should use Monday to begin working on assignments, and to make a plan for their learning during the week, including when they will join online “Tutoring/Q&A hours” with each of their teachers.

“Tutoring/Q&A Hours”

Teachers will offer tutoring/Q&A sessions to support student learning through online platforms such as Schoology Conferences or Zoom.

- This will be an opportunity for students to connect with their teachers and classmates, ask questions, and get assistance with assignments.
- To avoid conflicting sessions, and to allow flexibility for all students and families, tutoring/Q&A sessions will be offered based on content areas:
 - Math, Social Studies, and CTE teachers will offer one morning and afternoon session on Tuesdays and on Thursdays
 - English, Science, and LOTE (Foreign Language) teachers will offer one morning and one afternoon session on Wednesdays and Fridays
 - Fine Arts and Electives teachers will offer sessions on Tuesday and on Thursdays
- Sessions will last 1 hour. Students may choose which session(s) to attend based on their individual needs. Teachers will remain online for the full hour.
- Teachers will communicate instructions for logging in and joining these sessions with all students in Schoology.
- Students should plan to attend at least one session per week for each of their classes; they are not expected to join every session offered. Teachers will provide additional guidance regarding what students can expect during these online sessions.
