## SUMMARY OF VISA REGULATIONS IMMIGRATION ACT B.E. 2522 (1979 A.D.) AND RELEVANT TEXTS



### 1. GENERAL INFORMATION

1.1. A valid VISA OF ENTRY is necessary for EVERY ALIEN who wishes to enter the Kingdom of Thailand, except for certain restricted cases, details of which can be obtained from the Consular Section.

1.2. All types of VISA are issued according to the stated PURPOSE OF VISIT which must be CLEARLY STATED by the applicant. Failure to do so shall inevitably incur delays.

1.3. The visas which are issued by The Embassy or Consulates must be used within 3 months from the date of application. Upon arrival in Thailand, THE ACTUAL LENGTH OF STAY (Starting from the date of entry), shall be determined and granted at the discretion of Immigration Officers:

**According to the type and category of Visa in possession, Tourist Visa not exceeding 60 Days per entry for Nationals from 18 designated countries and passport holders from Hong Kong and Macau and, Tourist Visa not exceeding 30 days per entry for Nationals from other countries, Transit Visa not exceeding 3 Days per entry and Non-Immigrant Visa not exceeding 90 Days per entry. **Certain Nations in the Middle East, South Asia and East Asia Passport Holders**, please check basic documents required from our website [www.thaiembassyuk.org.uk](http://www.thaiembassyuk.org.uk).**

### 2. HOW TO APPLY FOR VISA

2.1. Complete and Sign ONE application form. A separate form is required for each traveller regardless of age.

2.2. Submit with the completed form

- Your Passport/Travel Document which should be valid for at least 6 Months from the date of application.
- Two recent photographs
- Appropriate fees (See 5)

2.3. For other purposes than tourism: Please submit EVIDENCE SUBSTANTIATING YOUR PURPOSE OF STAY.

Examples of such evidence are in case of transit, a confirmed travel document (air ticket etc.) showing Thailand as point of transit, in case of business trip, a letter from employer and/or business counterpart in Thailand, in case of working in Thailand, a letter of employment from your prospective employer, such document should be addressed to The Royal Thai Embassy, in case of settlement in Thailand with Thai spouse/Children/Parents, your certificate of marriage/birth. - **Consular Officers reserve the rights to request for additional documents as deemed necessary** •

**NOTE: Visa Applications must submitted by hand at the Consular Section, Royal Thai Embassy  
29 (Basement), Queen's Gate, London, UK, SW7 5JB (9.00-12.00 hours).**

**Applications submitted by hand take NOT LESS THAN UP TO (F) WORKING DAY TO PROCESS.**

### 3. VISA FEES

Visa fees must be paid in cash or postal order made payable to THE ROYAL THAI EMBASSY only.  
CHEQUES or CREDIT CARD ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE in any situations.

The following are the applicable fees :

- **Tourist Visa £ 21 as per entry (Up to 3 entries)**
- **Transit Visa £ 6 as per entry (Up to 3 entries)**
- **Non-Immigration Visa £ 1 for SINGLE ENTRY and £ 16 for MULTIPLE ENTRIES.**

### 4. HEALTH REQUIREMENT (SUBJECT TO CHANGES)

Persons holding Passports of or having residence in Countries in the Yellow Fever Area must produce a valid international health certificate for Yellow Fever protection at point of Entry into Thailand.
