

## New Jersey Film Tax Credit Tracking Sheet

The State of New Jersey Film Tax Credit provides production companies with a tax credit on qualified film production expenses incurred for the pre-production, production, and post-production of certain films in New Jersey. The tax credit may be increased if the production company submits a diversity plan that satisfies the requirement of the program. For the diversity plan to comply with the program statutes and regulations, production companies must make good faith efforts to hire New Jersey residents that represent the diversity of the State. To support the fact that an individual who worked on the production is a woman or minority person, the production company must provide this form to New Jersey Economic Development Authority.
