We understand the challenge of our mission, and we will maximise our positive impact on the workplace and environment.

We believe that no activity is so important that it cannot be carried out safely, securely and with due regard to the protection of the environment.

To achieve this we will:

- Set appropriate, contemporary standards for performance in environment, health, safety and security which we will meet or exceed, thereby complying fully with all legal requirements and relevant Government policies
- Clearly identify the NDA's environment, health, safety and security responsibilities and accountabilities, and ensure that everyone involved in their delivery is appropriately informed and trained

- Provide a secure working environment by protecting ourselves, our assets and our operations against risk of injury, loss or damage resulting from criminal or hostile acts
- Operate in an open and transparent manner, while protecting sensitive nuclear information
- Avoid complacency by challenging unacceptable behaviour and performance, and regularly reviewing our environment, health, safety and security processes, to ensure their effectiveness
- Monitor, audit and review our environment, health, safety and security performance, take action to deal with deficiencies and seek ongoing, sustained improvement
- Seek out good and adopt good practice, learn from experience, improve capability, capacity and develop a supportive culture within the organisation
- Expect those supporting the NDA's mission, including the supply chain, to work to our own high standards

In accordance with HSE guidelines, the NDA will lead by example and promote sharing and benchmarking of HSE best practice across the estate.
