

Camp Luther Packing Checklist 2019

Sleeping Gear

Camp Luther housing does not include bedding, so please bring your own.

- Sleeping Bag
- Pillow

Bathroom Gear

- Toothbrush/Toothpaste
- Shampoo/Conditioner/Body Soap
- Deodorant
- Other Toiletries
- Hairbrush or Comb
- Towel/Washcloth
- Bathroom Bag
- Laundry Bag

Clothing Items

On average, temperatures in the Northwoods are usually 70s and 80s during the day, and 50s and 60s at night. On cold nights, the temperature might drop into the 40s, so please bring some warm clothes!

- Underwear
- Socks
- Shorts
- Pants (jeans, sweats, etc.)
- T-shirts and long-sleeve shirts
- Changes of socks, underwear, etc.
- WARM CLOTHES—jacket, sweatshirts, stocking hat, lightweight gloves
- Pajamas
- Rain Jacket

Shoes

Please make sure to bring a pair of closed-toe shoes that are sturdy enough to use for running around and hiking. It's also useful to have a pair of sandals for wearing to the beach and for taking showers.

- Tennis Shoes/Athletic Shoes
- Sandals
- Shower/Beach Shoes

Swim Gear

- Swimsuit (one-piece or the equivalent please!)
- Beach Towel

Necessary Camp Gear

- Backpack
- Flashlight/Headlamp (w/ extra batteries)
- Sunscreen
- Bug Spray
- Water Bottle
- Sunglasses
- Hat

Other Essential Items

- Bible
- Any required medications (both prescription and OTC) in ORIGINAL CONTAINERS ONLY

Other Recommended Items

- Camera
- Paper/Pen, Post Cards, Envelopes, Stamps
