- ☐ 1. Students are directed on where to begin on the home page. (Ex: Start here button)
- ☐ 2. A self-introduction and welcome are provided by the instructor.
- ☐ 3. A syllabus is provided with all information required in the DACC Syllabus checklist.
- ☐ 4. A list of required materials is posted.
- ☐ 5. The course grading policy is provided.
- ☐ 6. Instructor contact information and office hours are provided.
- ☐ 7. Technology requirements are provided.

All items can be placed in the syllabus, home page, or week 0 in modules.

Organization and Navigation

- ☐ 1. Course content is organized in modules.
- ☐ 2. Modules are organized logically by topic, unit, or week.
- ☐ 3. Each module states the learning objectives that will be addressed.

Assessment and Feedback

- ☐ 1. Each module contains at least one formative assessment.
(Ex: quiz, assignment, discussion, etc.)
- ☐ 2. Multiple assessment strategies are used to measure student achievement throughout the course.
(Ex: formative assignments and summative assignments such as tests, projects, and papers.)
- ☐ 3. Instructions are provided for each assignment.
- ☐ 4. Due dates are listed for each assignment.
- ☐ 5. Grading criteria are provided for each assignment.

Communication and Interaction

- ☐ 1. Each module has a least one opportunity for student-instructor interaction.
(Ex: Feedback on an assignment, instructor interaction in discussions, Q&A sessions)
- ☐ 2. Opportunity for student-student interaction is provided in the course.
(Ex: Discussion forums, Zoom interactions, peer reviews, group projects)
- ☐ 3. Netiquette policies are provided.
(*Recommendation for Netiquette location: Syllabus or Getting Started module*)

Usability and Accessibility

- ☐ 1. Videos contain transcripts or are closed captioned.
(Ex. Create all new videos utilizing speech to text features with Zoom, YouTube, or similar.)
- ☐ 2. Images that are used for educational purposes (not decorative) have tags or descriptions.
- ☐ 3. Course structure is clear, consistent, and easy to navigate.
