

# Daily Schedule

### SAMPLE DAY 2

- 8:30** – Wake up
- 8:50** – Breakfast
- 9:10** – Log in to OLS, check and respond to e-mails, review class announcements, and determine tasks for the day
- 9:20** – Complete two English lessons
- 10:00** – Complete U.S. History lesson and the reading guide
- 11:00** – Complete Biology lessons and the study guide
- 11:30** – Make lunch for myself and little brothers
