Using technical writing and business development skills, the consultant will draft and finalize proposal content, including generating raw content from various sources into a cohesive and comprehensive package. Knowledge and experience with Federal procurement compliance is essential.

Areas of Responsibilities:

- Work with SFL staff to develop, write, and submit high-quality and competitive technical proposals.
- Provide technical insight and input across all elements that inform the technical approach, including appropriate levels of effort, execution of activities, partnering, and overall responsiveness to the proposal statement of work.
- Attend meetings, review sessions, and coordinate with SFL staff as required.
- Provide technical expertise and guidance to the proposal team during review sessions.
- Integrate the proposal team's comments through an iterative process.
- Identify and incorporate compelling research and data into proposals to support requests for funding.
- Ensure that the final technical proposal is cohesive and that the technical approach section is compliant
- Assist with other writing and development activities as assigned.
