**Homeschool Museum Classes** are held monthly on **every first Wednesday** from October to June. Each class is 2 hours long. (Age 3-4: 1 hour 30 min) The theme of each class changes from month to month. Students are divided into small groups by age, and each group works with the same museum educator, throughout the year. Classes take place in the Museum's permanent galleries and special exhibitions. The program is designed to be an interactive lesson that encourages students to examine objects and ideas through a variety of activities. Students can sign up for one, several or all of the classes.

**Student Fees:** \$10 per class (Museum Members) / \$12 per class (Non-Member) **Chaperones Fees:** \$6 per class (Museum Members) / \$7 per class (Non-Members) unless otherwise noted. \$1 off each class when signing up for 4 or more classes.
