The 4-H Council will pay \$1 per hour to work.

If you cannot work your assigned time you must find your own replacement.  
Younger 4-H members, age 12-13, will be allowed to work as replacements if necessary.  
Any change before Fair should be made by contacting the Extension Office, 402-372-6006.  
Any change during the Fair should be made with the manager of the 4-H Country Kitchen.

For persons with longer hair, you must have it tied back or the sides pulled off the face. All people working the food stand will be required to wear a cap. Caps worn (by male or female) must be clean and any logo must be respectable and appropriate. The food stand managers will have the final decision on the appropriateness of the cap.
