

# County Road 24 reconstruction project

## spring—fall 2017



Hennepin County, in partnership with the city of Plymouth, is reconstructing County road 24 in Plymouth between Olive Lane North and Jewell Lane North.

## Tentative project schedule

Crews will reconstruct the roadway over one construction season. Work is expected to begin in late spring 2017 and be complete by the end of the season, likely sometime in November.

## Project overview

This project is designed to improve traffic flow, safety and route continuity. Major improvements to the reconstructed area will include:

- Widening the road to add one lane in each and a shared center turn lane,
- Adding a trail along the south side of the road for a continuous shared-use route
- Improving sight lines and visibility
- Replacing aging water pipes

This work will create a consistent roadway and lane configurations between County Road 101 and Highway 55.

## Repaving project

In addition to the reconstruction work, current plans call for repaving of County Road 24 between Jewell Lane North and Highway 55. This work is tentatively scheduled for late summer. It will be relatively brief and will not likely require major additional closures or detours.

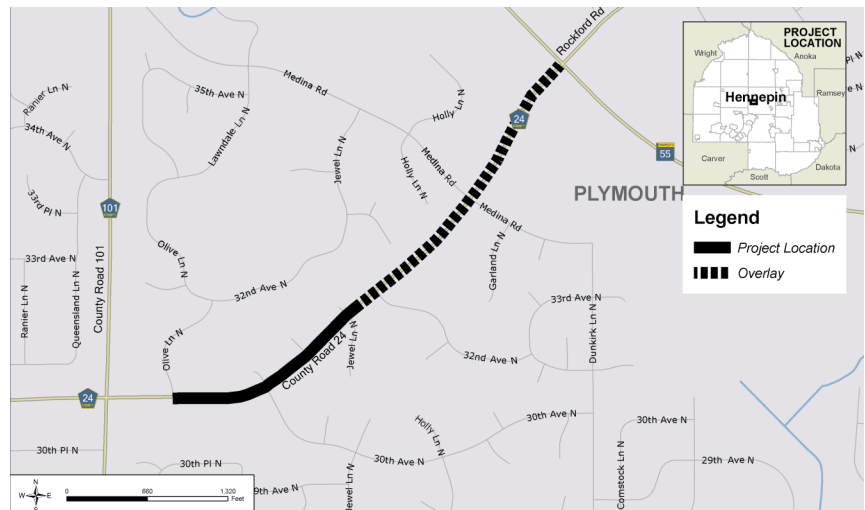

# Detour and travel considerations

- The detour for motorists during construction will follow County Road 101 to Highway 55.
- County Road 24 will be restricted to local traffic only between County Road 101 and Olive Lane North, as well as between Jewell Lane North and Medina Road.
- Access within the construction zone between Olive Lane and Jewel Lane will be maintained for residents living within construction limits only.
