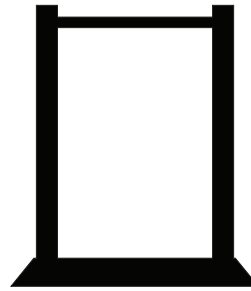

MENU & TABLE TENT CARE

- All Products should not be sprayed with ANY TYPE of harsh chemical cleaners such as Formula 409, Windex, or any type of bleach. The chemicals in these products will break down the components of the vinyl which the menu jackets are made of and will cause them to deteriorate.
- All Products should not be put in the dishwasher or submerged in water at any time.
- If necessary, products can be wiped gently with a damp (not soaked) cloth that has been treated with a small amount of diluted solution of mild (hand wash) dish detergent and warm water.
- Be careful never to spray anything on, wipe, or repeatedly rub the menu cover or tent.
- Do not stack large numbers of covers on top of each other.
- Make sure menus covers are folded properly on the spines before storing.
- Advise servers and host/hostesses not to “bang” covers against a table or counter top.
- Menu covers should be stored loosely in upright containers lined at the bottom with a foam panel. They should not be repeatedly “dropped” into a wooden menu holder with no lining or support at the bottom.
- Do not “overstuff” menu jackets with thick rigid filler boards and/or inserts or additions.
- Menu covers should be rotated regularly to ensure they are all being utilized at the same rate. If servers and host/hostesses are grabbing the same 25 covers from the top and using them over and over again without rotating, those covers will deteriorate at a much faster rate than those not being used as frequently.
