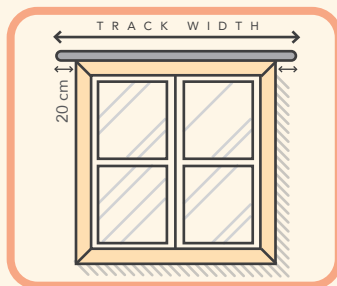

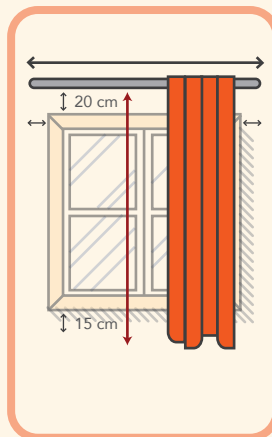
HOW TO MEASURE CURTAINS



MEASURE TRACK WIDTH

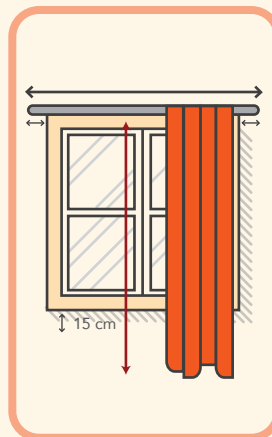
Measure the full width of your curtain track or rod, remembering to not include any decorative ends (finials). If you don't have a current track, measure the window frame width to determine how long the track or rod should be.

Include any frames and architraves, including areas where the curtains will be drawn. We recommend around **20 cm each side** or around **20% of the total window measurement**.



MEASURE CURTAIN DROP - ROD OR ROD TRACK

Measure from underneath the rod. If you don't have a rod, this measurement can be made around 20 cm above the top edge of the window frame or architrave.

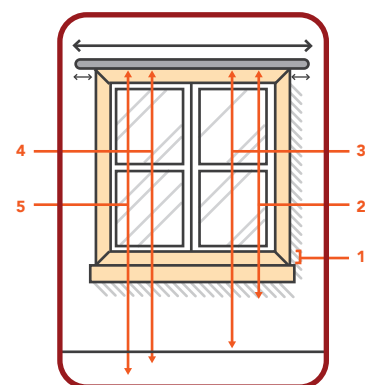


MEASURE CURTAIN DROP - USING TRACK

Measure from the top of the track. If you don't have a track in place, this is usually flush with the top edge of the architrave or 4 cm above the window frame.

WHERE TO MEASURE TO?

There are five common options for curtain length - each with unique aesthetic benefits. These include:



1. Window sill height
2. Just below window sill height
3. Floor height
4. Breaking floor height (extra 2 cm)
5. Puddling floor height (extra 20 cm)
