- 15 cards

 - No clipart/computer graphics, tracing or copying pictures
- Name of the character above the picture
- On the back (on the lined side of the card)
 - Greek and Roman name
 - Area of power
 - Relationship with at least two other god/goddess in mythology
 - Description of what they look like
