Article 1. SUBJECT AND VALUE OF THE CONTRACT

The Breeder hereby sells to the Buyer, for the amount of _____, a:

(Dam) _____, in accordance with the terms of this Contract.

Article 2. LIABILITY FOR MATERIAL DEFECTS

The Breeder guarantees that the Puppy is in good health on the date of delivery. The Buyer has the right to return the Puppy to the Breeder within 3 days after delivery and receive a refund of the purchase price if the Puppy is found by a veterinarian to be suffering from any disease.

Article 3. SPECIAL PROVISIONS FOR SHOW/BREEDING QUALITY PUPPY:

The Breeder provides the Puppy's pedigree, issued by the corresponding Kennel Club, to the Buyer prior to the Puppy's age of 6 months. The Breeder guarantees that the Puppy is free of visible hereditary defects to the best of his/her knowledge. Should the Puppy develop, prior to its 2nd birthday:

1. any disqualifying faults as defined in the current FCI Standard, and/or
2. severe hip dysplasia (classified by the FCI as E1 or E2, diagnosed by a veterinarian), and/or
3. absence of 2 or more premolars,

thereby causing the Breeder and the Buyer to agree that Puppy cannot participate in the shows nor ethically be bred, the Breeder will provide another puppy or refund the purchase price, based upon the Buyer's decision. The Buyer may keep the Puppy but it must be neutered.

Article 4. OBLIGATIONS OF BUYER

The Buyer shall maintain the Puppy in good condition, including adherence to a regular immunization schedule, good diet, and a clean and safe environment.

Article 5. FIRST PURCHASE OPTION OF BREEDER

If at any time in its life the Puppy is to be sold or given away, the Buyer shall give the Breeder first option to buy the Puppy back.

Article 6. SPECIAL LIMITATION

The Breeder shall not sell the Puppy, or its offspring (if any), to any individual in the business of buying and selling puppies for a profit.

Article 7. PROROGATION CLAUSE

Should any incongruity emerge, the Breeder and the Buyer will try to resolve the issue by mutual agreement. In the case that it is not possible to reach the agreement, a Court, established in the place of the Breeder's residence, will be employed.

Article 8. FINAL PROVISIONS

This contract is made up of four (4) identical copies. Each party reserves two (2) copies. By signing this document the Breeder and the Buyer have agreed to and read the terms and conditions carefully and are aware this Contract is legally binding.
