


University Honors Contract Courses



Definitions

Individual Contract--a University Honors student's agreement to do extra or different work in a non-honors designated course to earn honors credit.

Honors Team Contract—a collaborative Honors project in a non-honors designated course where multiple students agree to do extra or different work to earn honors credit.

Students may only take one contract course for honors credit.

Eligibility

- Students enrolled in University Honors who **have a legitimate course conflict**.
 - Conflict must be verified by student's major advisor
- Students must have completed one WSP course.

Contract Course Stipulations

- Course must be outside the student's major
- Course instructor must work with the student to determine the terms of the contract (what work will be completed to earn honors credit).
- Student must earn a "C" or better to receive honors credit.

Process

- Students and contract course instructors complete and sign an application for a contract course by the last month in the semester before the contract is to begin—October 31 for Spring courses and March 31 for Fall courses.
