Beyond meeting the minimum requirements for each leadership position, District 25 looks for leaders who exhibit skills in strategic thinking, project/program management, effective communication, leading teams, and effective training. Most importantly, a district leader needs to have a core understanding of Toastmasters International, including the mission, vision and interconnection among clubs, areas, divisions, and districts.

The committee considers all declared candidates and deliberations are confidential. Following the committee selection, the chairman notifies candidates nominated for office and confirms their willingness to accept the nomination.
