## Probation Policy

Undergraduate students who are off-track or whose UF, upper division, or department GPA falls below 2.0 will be placed on academic probation and will have two semesters to attain good academic standing. Any student who fails to meet the conditions of probation must petition the major department to be allowed to continue in the program. Approval of this petition will be at the discretion of the student's department. Extenuating circumstances should always be discussed with your advisor.

**\*Students may withdraw from the university at any time. However, withdrawal may affect ability to remain in a specific major.**  
**Students may be on academic probation for a maximum of TWO semesters while enrolled in the College of Engineering.**

All students on probation must meet with an academic advisor at designated intervals to review progress. It is the student's responsibility to understand the College probation policies. Failure to meet any condition of probation may result in dismissal from the College of Engineering.
