Revocation of Power of Attorney

Purpose

The principal revokes authority that was given to an agent under a previously recorded power of attorney.

Requirements

1. Name(s) of principal(s) revoking power. Please include the address. (N.J.S.A. 46:15-1.1, N.J.S.A. 46:6-6)
2. Name of the designated attorney-in-fact. Please include the address. (N.J.S.A. 46:15-1.1)
3. Date of the revocation. (N.J.S.A. 46:19-3)
4. Recording reference to original power of attorney, if recorded. Be sure to cite the correct Book and Page information.
5. Signature(s) of principal(s). (N.J.S.A. 46:15-1.1.a.(2))
6. Name(s) of principal(s) must appear typed or printed beneath signature(s). (N.J.S.A. 46:15-1.1.a.(4))
7. Signature(s) of principal(s) must be fully acknowledged by a notary public or other officer authorized by law to take oaths. Acknowledgment must include the state and county where the acknowledgment is taken, full date, name(s) of the principal(s) signing the revocation power of attorney. Notary or other officer taking the acknowledgment must sign the acknowledgment, print his/her name, title and jurisdiction. Notaries outside New Jersey must apply seal. (N.J.S.A. 46:15-1.1.a.(3), N.J.S.A. 46:14-2.1)
8. Record and return information on document. (N.J.S.A. 46:19-5)
9. Must be in English. (N.J.S.A. 46:15-1.1.a.(1))
