## YMCA BRIGHT BEGINNINGS VOLUNTEER CONTRACT

Thank you for volunteering for YMCA Bright Beginnings, we cannot do this important work without you! Once you've read this form in its entirety, please fill out the bottom section and return to the Kernersville Family YMCA in care of Pam Greene, Family Life Coordinator. Here are a few notes for you to remember:

1. Please arrive at least 30 minutes before your scheduled departure time to be paired with your student.
2. Check in at the Volunteer Registration Table to receive your name tag and school assignment.
3. Once paired with your student, try and create some rapport with them. Ask them about their summer, what they like to do, etc.
4. Elementary School and Middle School students other than your assigned child may not accompany you to the store. You are welcome to use our Child Watch areas during the event for ages 6 weeks to 11 years old. High School students may accompany you during the event but may not be left alone with the assigned child.
5. There is a \$25 maximum on purchases above the \$75 gift card to ensure that every child and volunteer is treated fairly. Please spend no more than \$25 of your own money on your assigned child.
6. Use all of the funds on the \$75 gift card and bring a little extra with you in case of taxes.
7. When checking out, please give your receipt to the YMCA staff person at the register. If you would like a tax receipt for any extra money you spent please tell them.
8. Once back at the YMCA, please continue to look after your assigned child until a parent/guardian comes to pick them up. If you cannot stay, please let us know in advance to have another volunteer or staff person there to watch the child.

### **How are the students chosen?**

### **How much money should I bring with me?**

There is a maximum personal spending of \$25. We ask that you bring enough to cover any taxes on items above the \$75 but please spend no more than the \$25 extra.
