

2020-2021 LEARNING CONTINUITY PLAN

[Senate Bill \(SB\) 98](#) established that the Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP) and an annual update to the LCAP are not required for the 2020-21 school year. Instead, it is being replaced with the Learning Continuity Plan.

The Learning Continuity Plan is intended to balance the needs of all stakeholders, including educators, parents, students and community members, while both streamlining engagement and condensing several preexisting plans. This document will address the plan for meeting students need during distance learning including: addressing gaps in learning; conducting meaningful stakeholder engagement, maintaining transparency; addressing the needs of unduplicated pupils, students with unique needs, and students experiencing homelessness; providing access to necessary devices and connectivity for distance learning; providing resources and supports to address student and staff mental health and social emotional wellbeing; and continuing to provide school meals for students.

A public hearing will be held at the Tracy Unified School District board meetings on September 9th and the plan will be submitted for board approval on September 22nd.
