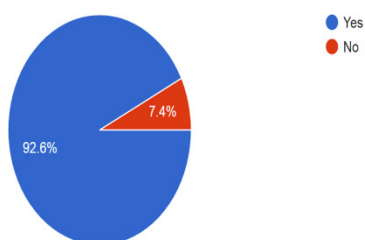


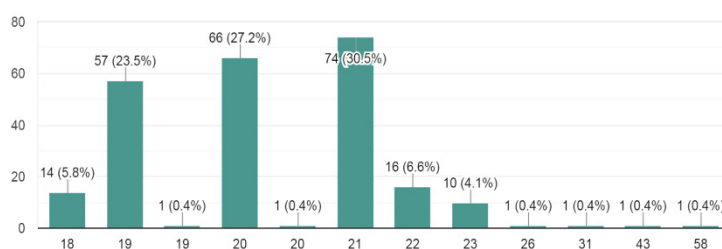
STUDENT SATISFACTION SURVEY REPORT ON TEACHING-LEARNING PROCESS 2019-20

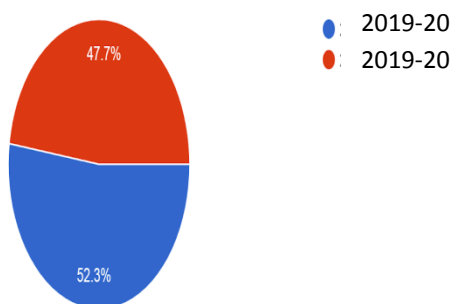

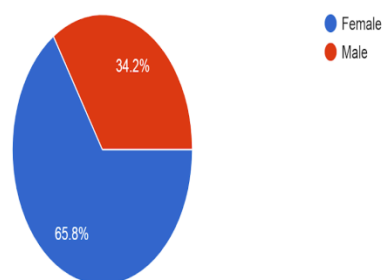

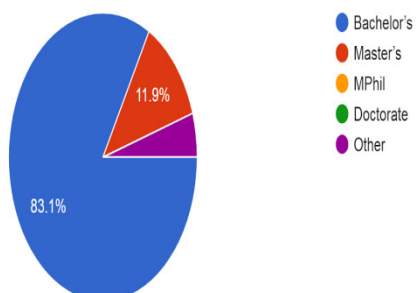

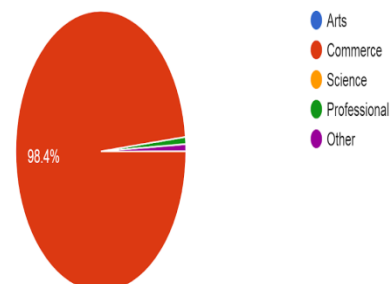

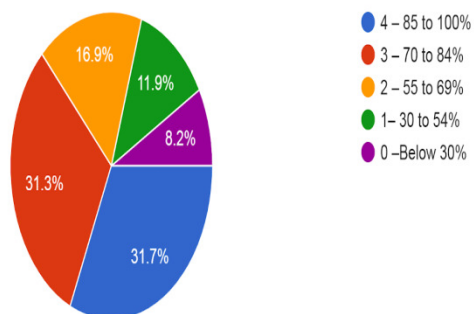


6. What subject area are you currently pursuing

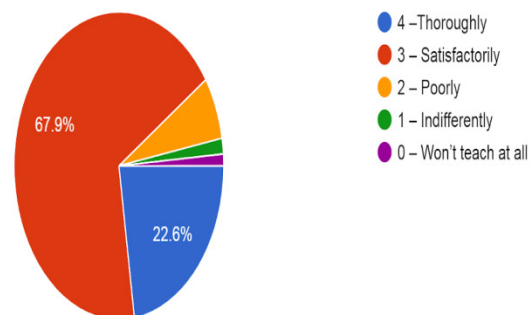
7. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class

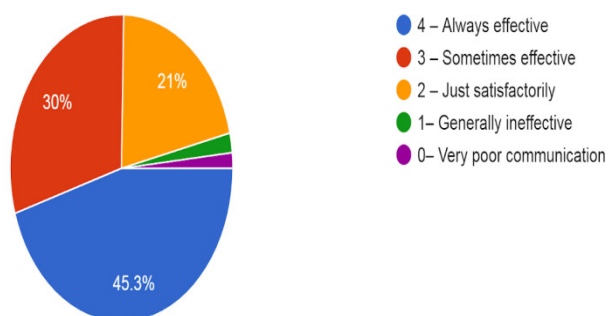
8. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes

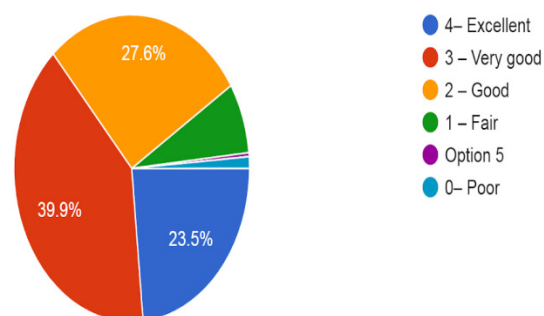
9. How well were the teachers able to communicate

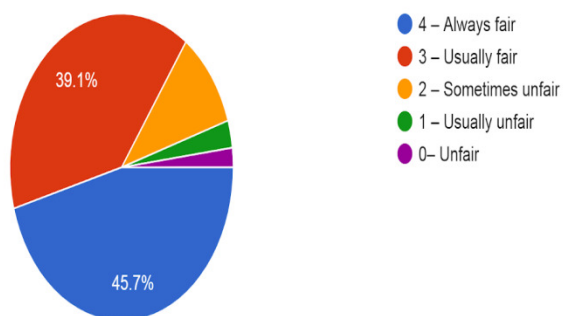
10. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as

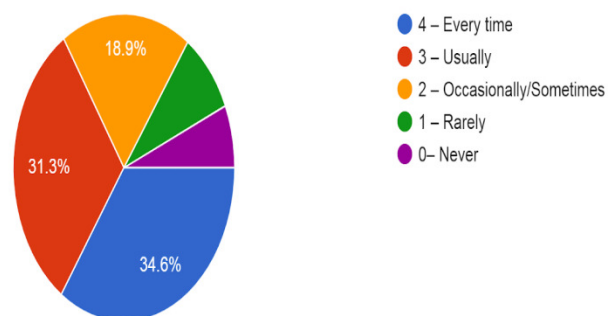
11. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.

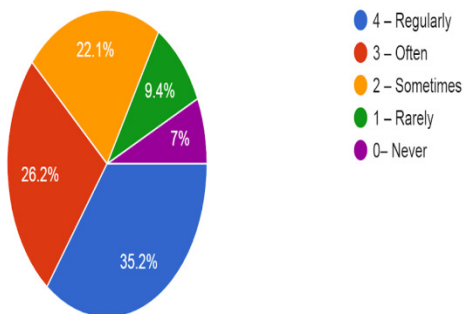

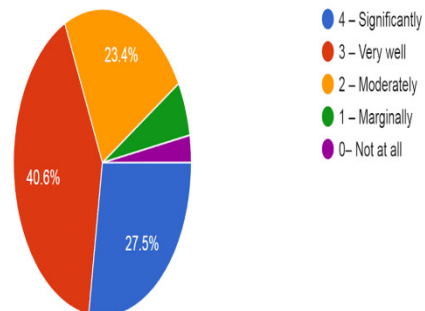
13. The institute takes an active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.

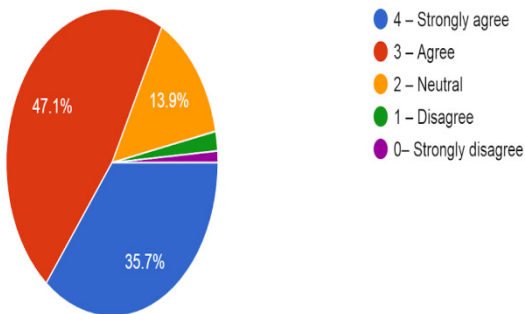

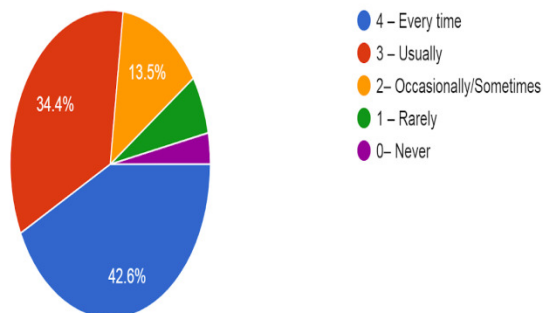

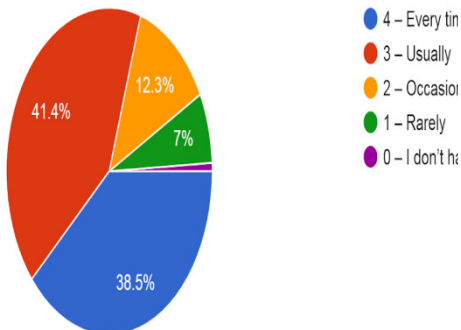

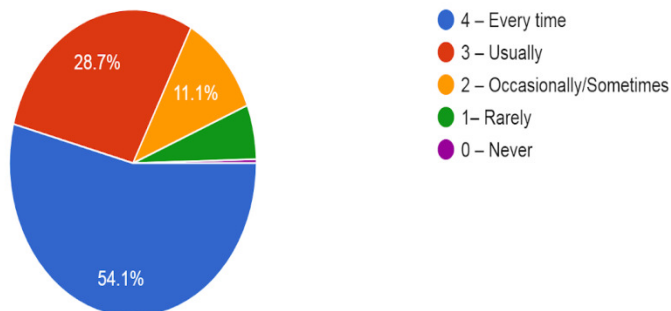

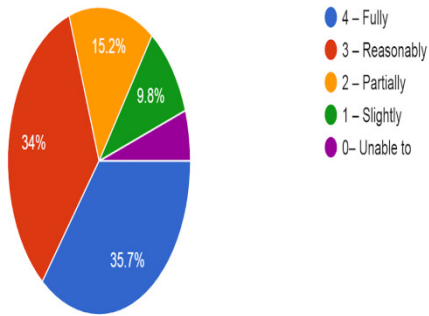


18. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.

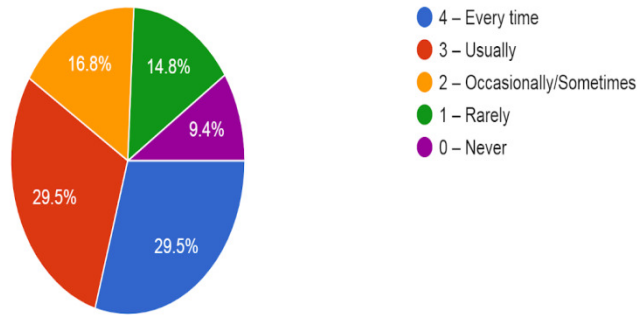

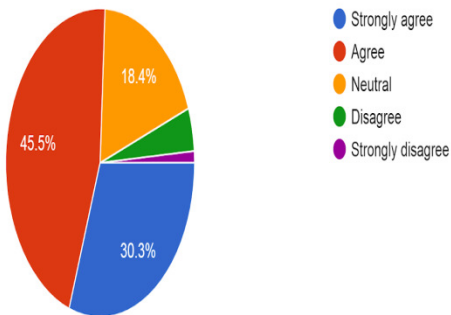

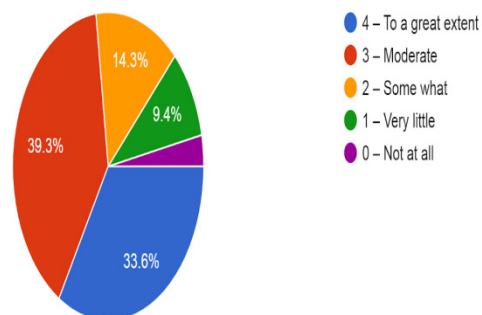

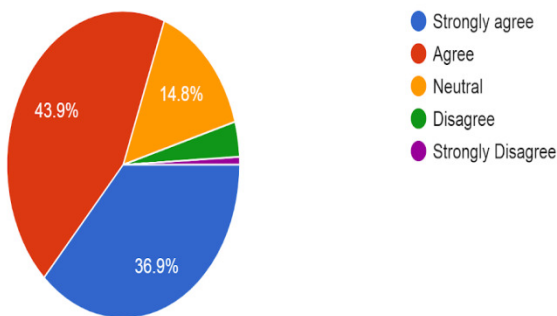

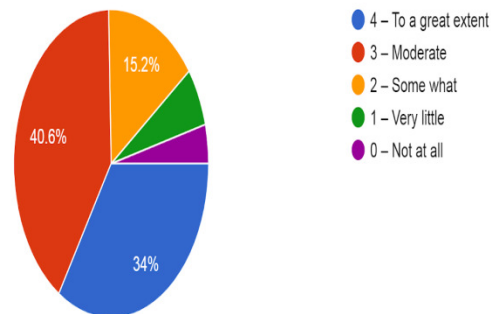

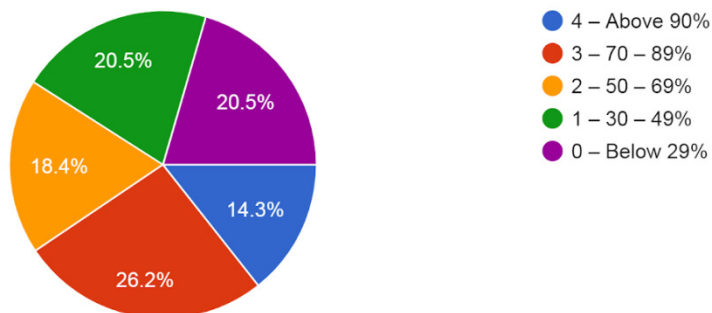
