The Office of Housing and Community Development of the City of Fort Lauderdale will be conducting an informational planning session to identify community needs and discuss current federal programs funded by the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). IT IS MANDATORY FOR NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS / PUBLIC SERVICE AGENCIES INTERESTED IN APPLYING FOR CDBG FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022 TO ATTEND THE PUBLIC MEETING IN ORDER TO BE ELIGIBLE TO APPLY. AN APPLICATION SUMMARY FORM WILL BE SENT ELECTRONICALLY TO THOSE PERSONS LISTED ON THE SIGN IN CARD.**

The Application Summary Form will be reviewed by staff to determine the project's eligibility. If the eligibility requirement is met and the public service project is deemed to have met a HUD National Objective, an application will be emailed directly to the organization(s).
