

# Clinical Requirement Checklist

As a health and service discipline, there are several clinical requirements for nursing students. The purpose of these is to protect you and the clients we serve and to be congruent with the expectations of the agencies in which we learn. Keeping your information current is your responsibility. Use this checklist to help guide as to what items need to be submitted. The following documents can be found by clicking on this link. **Due date for completing and submitting clinical requirements is January 4, 2016. A separate email will be sent in early December that contains the link to register for this system. All documents must be uploaded into this system.**

Items to be completed and submitted through the ACEMAPP system:

## 1. School of Nursing Immunizations/Vaccinations

- a. Tdap (Diphtheria/Tetanus/Pertussis) - *Provide documentation/proof of shot within the last 10 years.*
- b. MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella) - *documentation of two vaccinations or a titer to show immunity.*
- c. Hepatitis B Series - *documentation of three vaccinations or a titer to show immunity.*
- d. Tuberculosis **(two skin tests – four office visits) or TB blood test.**

*The first TB skin test must have been completed within the last twelve months. The second skin test must be no more than three months old. If you have not had a TB test within the last twelve months, please get two TB skin tests (four office visits). **OR**, one blood test (QuantiFERON TB Gold test). This is done instead of the two TB skin test listed above. Provide documentation/proof.*

- e. Varicella - *documentation of two vaccinations or a titer to show immunity.*
- f. Influenza - *to be completed starting in October for the 2015-2016 flu season.*

## 2. Copy of front and back of signed CPR card

*Needs to be under the American Heart Association guidelines for a Health Care Provider CPR certification. This includes AED, adult, child, and infant CPR ONLY.*

## 3. Clinical Orientation Training – HIPAA, Bloodborne Pathogens Assessment, and OSHA to completed in ACEMAPP.
