To be included on the plan holders list, receive notification of addenda, and to be eligible to bid, interested parties must download the Contract Documents from Quest. Those downloading the Contract Documents assume responsibility and risk for completeness of the downloaded Contract Documents.

III. PROJECT DESCRIPTION

1. Scope of Work: The scope of work for this project generally includes the following: surveying and construction staking; accessibility ramp modifications and new installations; asphalt concrete digout repairs; removal of existing traffic striping, pavement markings and markers; installation of polymer modified slurry seal; public notification including street posting; utility coordination; adjustment of utility and other appurtenances to finished grade; associated traffic control including all construction signs and equipment, flaggers, temporary signing and striping; installation of permanent striping, pavement markings and markers; and all other incidentals necessary to complete the work. Additive alternate bid items work include: raising utility company appurtenances to grade.

2. Bids are required for the entire work described in the project plans, specifications, and contract documents, and must be submitted on the forms contained therein.
3. Contract Working Days: Total contract time is 40 working days.
4. Engineer's Estimate is between: \$650,000 – \$725,000

IV. BID PROPOSAL REQUIREMENTS

1. Bid Opening is at City Council Chambers, Campbell City Hall, 70 North First Street, Campbell, CA
2. Bid Opening Date and Time: **APRIL 10, 2018 AT 3:00 P.M.**
3. Required Bid Security: 10% Bid Bond
4. Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting: Prospective bidders are required to attend a mandatory pre-bid meeting. This meeting will be held at **1:30 PM, on Wednesday, March 28, 2018**, in the Council Chambers at City Hall, which is located at 70 North First Street, in downtown Campbell, California. Bids for this Project will not be accepted from Contractors that did not attend the Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting.
5. Required Licenses: The Contractor shall possess a valid Class "A" General Engineering Contractor License at the time of bid. Contractor shall maintain said license throughout the entire project until Notice of Final Acceptance has been issued. Failure to possess the specified license shall render the bid as non-responsive and shall act as a bar to award the Contract to any bidder not possessing said license at the time of bid and forfeiture of the bid will result. All contractors and subcontractors shall have and maintain a current and valid contractor license of the required classification from the State of California throughout the course of this project.

All contractors and subcontractors working in the City of Campbell must have a valid City of Campbell Business License at the time the Contract is awarded. Business Licenses can be purchased at the Finance Department at 70 N. First Street, Campbell, California.
