The stratified tournaments use the extremely popular 12-board mini format, allowing players with limited time to have the tournament experience at their convenience. Players can combine two 12-board minis to play the more traditional 24-board tournament.</p> <p>OKbridge's products offer a highly intuitive interface, advanced functionality and unprecedented flexibility. An annual membership of \$99 includes unlimited play (including non-ACBL masterpoints tournaments), the opportunity to chat online with other members, "kibitz" the pros as well as access up-to-date bridge articles and expert advice. OKbridge also offers 7 daily, stratified ACBL tournaments. These tournaments are available for only \$49 per year with membership for unlimited play.
