LEVEL OF COVID	RESPONSE
<p>No cases of COVID on the Island (community) LEVEL 1</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All services continue as normal</li> <li>• Good hygiene measures in place (staff and customers)</li> <li>• All staff in work</li> </ul>
<p>Low number of cases of COVID on the Island LEVEL 2</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Increased and improved levels of hygiene and cleaning by staff and customers</li> <li>• Amend the Programming of activities (swimming, gym, halls etc) to allow for gaps to clean. PPE required.</li> <li>• Maintain customer records for contact tracing purposes of those attended services and activities</li> <li>• Vulnerable individuals and groups advised not to attend activities and / or these sessions cancelled.</li> <li>• Guidance issued to sports governing bodies to reflect the IOM Govt (Public Health advice)</li> <li>• Social distancing measures in place</li> <li>• For swimming related activities follow Swim England &amp; RLSS guidance</li> <li>• Signage in place throughout facility and information easily available to customers and staff</li> <li>• Communication to customers and staff to advise of changes, updates and guidance</li> <li>• Follow OHR Policy regarding staff attendance at work</li> <li>• Any staff who are displaying symptoms – see action card and follow Public Health advice</li> <li>• Any customer who tests positive after attending the NSC follow public health advice (see action card)</li> </ul>
<p>Moderate number of cases of COVID on the Island LEVEL 3</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Increased cleaning and hygiene practices</li> <li>• Maintain customer records for contact tracing purposes</li> <li>• Restrictions on some activities (indoor with high aerobic and increased risk of transmission cancelled)</li> <li>• Outdoor activities risk assessed to determine what remains in place</li> <li>• Follow OHR Policy regarding staff attendance at work. Some staff to work from home where they can do their job and others remain in work but spread out within office or in own office or are redeployed.</li> <li>• Updated guidance issued to sports and recreation clubs and associations as per public health advice</li> <li>• Social distancing in place. No large group activities or close contact / interactions</li> <li>• Communication to customers and staff to advise of changes and updates</li> <li>• Any staff who are displaying symptoms – see action card and follow Public Health advice</li> <li>• Any customer who tests positive after attending the NSC follow public health advice (see action card)</li> </ul>
<p>Significant number of cases of COVID on the Island LEVEL 4</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Closure of face to face services and activities indoors and outdoors</li> <li>• On-line exercise activities (zoom)</li> <li>• Follow OHR Policy regarding staff attendance at work. Staff work from home or are redeployed into essential services</li> <li>• Updated guidance issued to sports and recreation clubs and associations as per public health advice and or legislative framework.</li> <li>• Communication to customers and staff to advise of changes and regular updates there-after.</li> </ul>
