## **1. AUTHORSHIP STATEMENT AND AGREEMENT**

### **Introduction**

All authors have to read and sign the following form that itemize main issues of their scientific work (study/article/research/review, etc.) and its publishing in RJLM. Issues listed below deals with:

1. *authorship statement and agreement,*
2. *copyright transfer agreement,*
3. *disclaimer and disclosure statement,*
4. *ethics board review and institutional ethics review board and/or animal care and ethics committee approval (if required)*

The first author should sign this document and co-distribute it to his co-authors for their original ink signatures to. Only fully completed and signed document will be uploaded scanned on the Journal website [www.rjlm.ro](http://www.rjlm.ro) together with the work, tables, etc.

Submitting the authorship statement and agreement form **is mandatory** for further submitting any article and any further decisions regarding the publication in RJLM.

Every author signing this document accepts that the content is true and free of ethical or legal issues.

### **Originality**

Each author warrants that his or her submission to the article/scientific work is original. Neither this article/scientific work nor a similar work has been published nor shall be submitted for publication elsewhere while under consideration by this Publication.

### **Authorship responsibility**

Each author certifies that she or he is an author of the work (according to the ICMJE's Recommendations for the Conduct, Reporting, Editing, and Publication of Scholarly Work in Medical Journals Updated December 2015 [<http://www.icmje.org/icmje-recommendations.pdf>]) and fulfill all 4 required criteria:
