

Disproportionality Compliance Action Plan Public Reporting

The State of Arkansas is required to analyze the rates of suspensions and expulsions for students with disabilities exceeding ten days in a school year. The rates are determined by Indicator 4A: Suspension/Expulsion and Indicator 4B: Suspension/Expulsion by Race and Ethnicity.

If the analysis suggests a significant differences in the suspensions/expulsions rates of students with disabilities and the suspension/expulsion rates of general education or a significant difference in the suspension/expulsion rates of students by race, and the suspension/expulsion rates of all general education students, then the district must review its current policies, procedures, and practices.

Data analysis has identified Pine Bluff School District as having a significant difference in discipline and disproportionate representation in Indicator 4A and Indicator 4B. Therefore, the Pine Bluff School District has written and is implementing the Compliance Action Plan to address inappropriate policies, procedures, and practices in the discipline of students with disabilities.
