PLEASE NOTE: All courses, assessments, and student teaching **MUST** be completed to be considered a program completer and your *College Verification Form* for a Virginia Department of Education license to be signed YES. Choosing to accept a full time position instead of completing all education and/or content courses, all required assessments for licensure, and/or student teaching required for the Old Dominion University state-approved program will result in the college verification form for a Virginia Department of Education license being signed as "NO, you did not complete a state-approved preparation program". If you plan to relocate outside of Virginia, it is highly recommended that you complete the ODU state-approved program (all content and education courses, required assessments, and student teaching) components needed for licensure. The vast majority of states that you will be relocating to will require a college verification form stating that you have "completed a state-approved preparation program", including student teaching. Experience in public schools or teaching on a provisional license, does not meet the requirement of student teaching as a "state-approved program".
