The signature on your vote-by-mail envelope does not match the signature in your voter record.

The Humboldt County Office of Elections received your vote-by-mail ballot envelope, but your signature does not match the signature in your voter record. By law, a voter's signature must be verified before the ballot may be counted. Your signature may have changed over time.

READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY.

FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS MAY CAUSE YOUR VOTE-BY-MAIL BALLOT NOT TO COUNT.

In order to ensure that your vote by mail ballot will be counted, your statement must be received by the Humboldt County Office of Elections no later than 5 pm two days prior to the certification of the election.

Fill out and sign the Signature Verification Statement. It can be returned to the Office of Elections in any of the following ways:

- **Come to our office in person.**

SIGN your original vote by mail ballot envelope or deliver this completed Signature Verification Statement. This must be done before by 5:00 pm two days prior to the certification of election.

- **Deliver your signed statement on Election Day** to a voter assistance center in Humboldt County before the close of polls (8:00 pm) on Election Day, November 3, 2020.

- **Mail your signed statement in the enclosed envelope.** The Signature Verification Statement must be received at our office before 5:00 pm two days before election certification. Postmarks will not count. If you return your statement via mail, use the enclosed, self-addressed, stamped envelope.

- **Fax or scan and email the signed statement to our office.** It must be received at our office before 5:00 pm two days before election certification.

SIGNATURE VERIFICATION STATEMENT

I, _____(Voter Name), am a registered voter of Humboldt County, State of California. I declare under penalty of perjury that I requested and returned a vote-by-mail ballot. I am a resident of the precinct in which I have voted, and I am the person whose name appears on the vote-by-mail ballot envelope. I understand that if I commit or attempt any fraud in connection with voting, or if I aid or abet fraud or attempt to aid or abet fraud in connection with voting, I may be convicted of a felony punishable by imprisonment for 16 months or two or three years. I understand that my failure to sign this statement means that my vote-by-mail ballot will be invalidated.
