

# CAN WE BENEFIT FROM AUDIT/INSPECTION SOFTWARE?

- Is the maintenance department often overwhelmed due to dealing with a flood of problems that could have been prevented with earlier attention?
- Do you have to manage large stacks of paper audit/inspection forms?
- Do you have storage-space issues due to saving old audit/inspection forms?
- Do the same problems continue to be detected by audits and inspections?
- Are personnel frustrated because they point out problems that aren't getting fixed?
- Are personnel completing paper forms in advance for future use.
- Are personnel pencil-whipping your paper inspection forms?
- Have you ever received a fine, or fear fines, for non-compliance?
- Are you not conducting some audits or inspections that you should be conducting, hoping that no one will ask to see them?
- Are you using generic forms that don't quite fit what's being audited or inspected?
- Do you not always know who conducts audits or inspections?
- Do personnel not respect the auditing and inspecting process because they don't see evidence that the company values audits and inspections?

The more "yes" answers you have on this checklist, the more you stand to gain from software.
