Undergraduate Research & Creative Opportunity (URCO) Matching Funds
Proposal Cover Page

Undergraduate students with a major in a CCA department (Art+Design, Music, or Theatre) are eligible to apply for up to \$750 as matching funds for URCO applications.

All awards will include \$250 matching funds toward the \$1,000 URCO scholarship (the Office of Research provides the other \$750). Awards may also include up to \$500 toward \$1,000 for eligible project expenses (the Office of Research also provides up to \$500 – the CCA and Office of Research split these expenses 50/50).

In addition to this cover page, students must submit the following:

- A project abstract: A 1-2 paragraph summary of the proposed project. This should be written using language that people who are not familiar with your discipline can understand; avoid jargon and technical terms).
• The following URCO proposal elements, which are also required by the Office of Research.
o Proposal Narrative (2,500 word maximum)
o Timeline (Using the template provided by the Office of Research)
o Education Plan
o Budget & Commitment (Using the template provided by the Office of Research)
o Faculty Mentor Letter of Support
o Students' curriculum vitae (CV)

The deadlines for consideration are each February 5, June 5, and October 5; note that these internal deadlines are 10 days prior to the Office of Research URCO deadlines.
