

Gun Club Proposal for Amendment

WILLISTON TOWN NOISE ORDINANCE

The Williston Selectboard proposes to amend Section 6.13 of the Williston Noise Control Ordinance, adopted October 25, 2004, as follows:

6.13. The use of firearms when used for hunting in accordance with state Fish and Wildlife laws or when used for sport shooting consistent with any permitting conditions placed on such use. For sport shooting uses permitted prior to January 1, 2005, the hours of operation ~~will be determined through a written agreement with the Town~~ shall be as follows:

- a. Regular Hours
 - a. Wednesday, 4:00 p.m. to dusk.
 - b. Sunday, 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- b. Special Events
 - a. Special events may be held outside of regular hours on the condition that a representative of the shooting club notifies the Williston Police Department and the Williston Town Manager of such event by email, at least 48 hours in advance thereof and provided further that the event occurs between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.
- c. “Special events” means shooting events held outside of the regular shooting schedule identified above.
- d. The number of Special events shall average no more than sixteen (16) events per year over a 3 year rolling period with no more than three (3) special events held on Saturdays in any given month.
- e. In addition to “Special Events,” up to four (4) hunter safety courses per calendar year may be run on Saturdays, provided the course is certified by the Vermont Fish and Wildlife Department or successor state agency or department.
