

edTPA Timeline During Student-Teaching

While the timeline below represents the schedule in a typical student teaching semester, the edTPA Leadership Team develops each semester's timeline after consideration of the PK-12 academic calendars.

Prior to student-teaching

- Attend mandatory edTPA intro meeting where edTPA expectations are covered and the student-teacher is informed of their (FERPA related) professional responsibilities in the classroom
- Become familiar with edTPA handbook and requirements
- Review timeline and note important dates

Week 1 of student-teaching

- Discuss edTPA requirements, handbook and timeline with cooperating teacher
- Get approval and send parent permission forms home

Week 2 of student-teaching

- Discuss projected teaching and curriculum over the next few weeks – especially week 5 – with cooperating teacher.
- Complete "Context for Learning"

Week 3 of student-teaching

- Attend Workshop #1: edTPA Deep Dive - Planning for Instruction and Assessment
- Read and be knowledgeable about the requirements for Task 1: Planning for Instruction and Assessment

Week 4 of student-teaching

- Complete edTPA lesson plans (including instructional materials and planned assessments)
- Attend Workshop #2: Planning Commentary and Preparing to Capture Student Learning
- Read and be knowledgeable about the requirements for Task 2: Instructing and Engaging Students in Learning
- Complete Planning Commentary

Week 5 of student-teaching

- Video record edTPA lesson segments
- Assess student learning and provide effective feedback to students
- Read and be knowledgeable about the requirements for Task 3: Assessing Student Learning

Week 6 of student-teaching

- Attend Workshop #3: Video Selection and Effective Student Feedback
- Finish video recording edTPA lesson segments
- Select, clip and compress video to submit for edTPA
- Select three representative student work samples/artifacts

Weeks 7-8 of student-teaching

- Attend Workshop #4: Instruction and Assessment Commentaries and Put It Together!
- Complete instruction commentary

Complete assessment commentary

Weeks 9-10 of student-teaching

Finalize edTPA portfolio

Submit edTPA to Pearson and edTPA leadership team
