After School Programs:

Crazy Chemworks Grades K-5 Mondays Oct. 19- Nov. 23 (6 weeks) 3:30 - 4:30 pm

FREE Fire and Ice show to be held in the auditorium @ 2pm on Tuesday, October 6th

Mad Science will provide all materials and instructors for these events. The school will provide a suitable room, table and chairs, electricity and water. The school will promote this program and accept registration from children through the system employed. Mad Science will charge \$72 per student enrolled. Mad Science requires a minimum of 10 enrolled children in order to perform these activities. Mad Science can conduct these activities for a maximum of 25. If registration demands exceed the maximum number, Mad Science can split the class if the school determines that it has the space to do so.

Mad Science will provide a short description of these activities, along with logos, for the school to use in promotional materials.

Mad Science understands the nature of response to registration and is prepared to cancel any or all of the activities one week prior to the start dates.

General Notes:

Mad Science of Pittsburgh carries a general liability insurance policy and is prepared to send a certificate to the school and/or the district upon request.

All instructors employed by Mad Science have the appropriate clearances required to work with children in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Short Descriptions:

Crazy Chemworks: Shake up a flask of fun in the lab as a junior chemist! This hands-on and interactive program of chemistry for children ages 5-12 is packed solid with cool reactions. Students put on goggles and change liquid to solid and back again. They get to handle laboratory tools, build and break molecules, and pick up some tricks on chemical changes.
