PROCESS AND PROJECT MANAGEMENT

Openly Connected, follows a standard, repeatable process for all of our engagements large and small. The OC development process is a combination of Generally Accepted, Best Practices for Software Development and our customized approach based on our experience after 100's of engagements of nearly persuasion and outcome.

Openly Connected follows a standard 4 step (unified) project management process.

1. **Inception** - We start each project with a discovery to gain a concept and understand of the goals and objectives of our clients. In this stage we propose solutions and work with clients to define the approach we will take in the project.
2. **Elaboration** – after we understand the business objectives, we then develop the specifications, project plans and official proposals as well as Budgetary and Project Duration Estimates.
3. **Construction** – Once we have a solid blue print of the project and an agreement, it is time to develop code, select modules and make customizations.
4. **Transition** – after thorough testing, when OC and the client agree the product meets the specification, clients will be given the appropriate training, the site is ready to go live. If necessary, OC hosting / supporting agreements will in place.

Note: all invoices must be cleared prior to stage 4 implementation.

DEVELOPMENT PROCESS

The **Inception phase** will be conducted by Openly Connected partners or senior developers will begin the development process with each client as well as **Elaboration** at which point Openly will work closely with the client to develop a budget for the project. The Development budget should include, hosting and maintenance support for the first year of operation.

The Project Development Budget is a key element of the **Project Plan** for building out the project. In essence, the **Development Budget** is an outline for the entire project as it is the estimated amount of time & money necessary to complete the project and an outline of how that money will be spent throughout the project.

It is very important to understand the proposal is only an estimate of the amount of time and money necessary to complete the project. Just as the project plan is a road map of the requirements, scope and technology used in the project. More often than not, in spite of strenuous due-diligence and planning changes creep in causing the project to run longer.

Client introduced change may have a direct impact on how long the project is going to take and how much it is going to cost. Likewise unforeseen technical issues may also have similar effects.

No changes to the project, which will negatively effect the budget or time-line will be introduced, without prior written client approval.

As the **Construction Phase** begins, the Project Manager will be in charge of implementing the project plan and ensuring everyone is fulfilling their responsibility to the project. A large part of the PM's responsibility is to maintain close contact with the client, informing her of development progress, the hourly burn rate and of any issues which may effect the projects progress either way.

The client has a good deal of control of how closely their project tracks to the budget.

With the help of their project manager, a client can ensure only the most necessary changes are made to the design and they are done at the right time to lessen the impact on the over project cost.

DEVELOPMENT

While your project is in the **Construction phase**, development work will be done, usually on an Openly Connected development server. Openly Connected encourages you to follow along as your site is being developed. We strongly encourage our clients to follow along, look for opportunities to test and provide feedback along the way rather than waiting to the end of the project were it may take longer and cost more to make changes at the end. Your project manager will keep you abreast of which server is being used and how and were to get involved.

Openly Connected provides a project management portal, the **Openly Connected Hub** where the status of the project is documented including development hours burned & remaining, project tasks, specification documentation, access to 3rd party sites really all the information that is worth keeping on the project is kept there.

TESTING

Openly Connected developers test all code as they develop it, this is "unit testing", team members test larger sections of the application as it is developed which is "component testing." When development is completed, an OC Team Member will test the entire site, to ensure it conforms with the proposal and specification, which constitutes "system testing". When the project passes OC's System Testing it is then submitted to the client for acceptance testing. **Openly Connected's Integrated Testing Practice**, through-out the life cycle of the project ensures it conforms to the specification and works correctly prior ever turning it over to the client.

When the site is complete and fully tested by the development team, it is time for the clients to review the site to validate all aspects of functionality, features and design. It is the responsibility of the client to test the work product, on their own to ensure they are fully satisfied with all aspects of the work product as it is delivered.

It is vital for the client to critically review each aspect of the site. Prior to putting the site live on the Internet; the client will deem the site acceptable. When the client finds the site meets their business needs, the specification and their general satisfaction they may accept the project as complete.

When the project is accepted by both the client and Openly Connected, it is installed in the production environment and tested once again, after which the site can be promoted to a production status. At that time the client has an additional 30 Days to review the site for any flaws or places where it does not conform to the final tested and accepted specification, these issues Openly Connected will immediately repair as part of the initial agreement.

PROJECT COMPLETION

It is very important to know when the project is complete, and will not be posted live on the Internet for general use, until it is accepted as complete.

This project is complete when:

1. The project plan work assignments are completed to an acceptable level per the project plan
2. Openly Connected has performed passing “Full System Test “
3. Client performs “acceptance testing” and provides sign-off
4. All the final invoices are paid
